 - b) No person shall sell, offer for sale, or offer for promotional purposes any zinc-carbon battery manufactured on or after the date of enactment of this Act, that contains mercury that was intentionally introduced.
 - c) No person shall sell, offer for sale, or offer for promotional purposes any button cell mercuric-oxide battery

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for use in the United States on or after the date of enactment of this Act.

d) On or after the date of enactment of this Act, no person shall sell, offer for sale, or offer for promotional purposes a mercuric-oxide battery for use in the United States.

2. Cadmium CAS No 7440-43-9 EC No 231-152-8 and its compounds	Portable batteries, whether or not incorporated into appliances, light means of transport or other vehicles, shall not contain more than 0,002 % of cadmium (expressed as cadmium metal) by weight
3. Lead CAS No 7439-92-1 EC No 231-100-4 and its compounds	1. From 18 August 2024, portable batteries, whether or not incorporated into appliances, shall not contain more than 0,01 % of lead (expressed as lead metal) by weight. 2. (2) According to the EU New Battery Regulation (EU) 2023/1542, portable batteries (non portable zinc-air

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button cells) containing between 0,004 %-0.01 % lead, shall be marked with the chemical symbol for the metal concerned: Pb.

Unless otherwise stated, the decision rule for conformity reporting is based on the non-binary statement with guard band (is equal to the expanded measurement uncertainty with a 95% coverage probability, $w = U95$) in ILAC-G8:09/2019 Clause 4.2.3.

A. "Pass - the measured value is within (or below / above) the acceptance limit, where the acceptance limit is below / above to the guard band." or "Pass - The measured values were observed in tolerance at the points tested. The specific false accept risk is up to 2.5%."

B. "Conditional Pass - The measured values were observed in tolerance at the points tested. However, a portion of the expanded measurement uncertainty intervals about one or more measured values exceeded / out of tolerance. When the measured result is close to the tolerance, the specific false accept risk is up to 50%."

C. "Conditional Fail - One or more measured values were observed out of tolerance at the points tested. However, a portion of the expanded measurement uncertainty intervals about one or more measured values were in tolerance. When the measured result is close to the tolerance, the specific false reject risk is up to 50%."

D. "Fail - the measured value is out of (or below / above) the tolerance limit added / subtracted to the guard band." or "Fail - One or more measured values were observed out of tolerance at the points tested". The specific false reject risk is up to 2.5%.
